CIST 2431 – UNIX/Linux Introduction

A currently enrolled or accepted program student may receive course credit by passing the CIST 2431 exemption examination administered by the Gwinnett Technical College Assessment Center. The policy regarding Experiential Credit and Credit by Examination is in the College catalog. **The examination must be completed prior to registration for the class for which the student is seeking credit by examination. Students may not request exemption tests for courses in which they have been enrolled nor may they take an exemption test more than once.**

The CIST 2431 exemption examination will cover these competencies:

1. History of UNIX/Linux and the UNIX/Linux Environment
2. Logging In and Out
3. User Environment
4. File System Hierarchy (or tree)
5. Editors
6. Help (manual) Pages
7. Commands and Options
8. File and Directory Management

A student needs to score an 80% or higher on the CIST 2431 exemption examination to receive exemption credit.
