Transfer Steps from Dual Enrollment to Regular Admit Student

ADVISEMENT:

1. **Meet with a Gwinnett Tech Enrollment Advisor** in the One Stop Center on either campus (Building 100 in Lawrenceville or the front desk for Alpharetta-North Fulton) and let them know you would like to become a regular admit college student.

APPLY:

2. Access www.GwinnettTech.edu
 - Select Admissions on the menu bar
 - Select Apply Now from the drop down menu
 - Click Returning Students
 - Follow steps 1-3 under the Returning Students Application.

GETTING STARTED:

3. If you are interested in starting the Summer after you graduate from high school, you will need to **submit a copy of your current high school transcript, as well as a letter from your high school counselor with your upcoming graduation date stating that you are on track to graduate.**

TRANSCRIPTS:

4. Once you have graduated from high school, you must **submit a sealed official copy of your final high school transcript with your graduation date.**

FINANCIAL AID:

5. **During the admissions process, complete the FAFSA application (fafsa.gov).** You will not be eligible to receive any financial aid until after your final high school transcript has been received, therefore, classes taken the Summer after high school would not be eligible for financial aid.
