English Language Program Class Description

Students need to take the level class Part 1 & Part 2 to get the complete program and advance speaking ability and accuracy. Part 1 & Part 2 have lessons in Vocabulary, Listening, Speaking, Grammar, Reading, Writing and Pronunciation. This is the best way to get the practice and skills needed to be fluent. The intensive or accelerated program is the best way to progress. Students will learn more quickly if they take 4 or 5 days a week.

Two day only students need to change days each session to take the Monday/Wednesday Part 1 for one session and then take the Tuesday/Thursday Part 2 for the next session to advance and truly learn all skills.

Levels: Gwinnett Campus Foundations, Low Beginning, Beginning, High Beginning, Low Intermediate, Intermediate, High Intermediate, Low Advanced, Advanced, High Advanced, Advanced Grammar review & Writing.

Alpharetta-North Fulton Campus Beginning Level ONLY

2 day classes: *Monday/ Wednesday Part 1 or Tuesday/Thursday Part 2*

Students need to complete both Part 1 & Part 2 to progress. These classes are for students who have restricted schedules and cannot take more days a week. We suggest that students take more than 2 days of English a week.

Intensive English Language Program: *Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday (Part 1 & Part 2 together)*

Part 1 & Part 2 are classes are designed for students who want to learn English quickly. These classes are four days a week for intensive English learning.

Accelerated English Language Program: *Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday & Friday*

(Part 1 & Part 2 & extra Friday conversation & pronunciation)

The classes are for students who need to improve their English skills quickly. Five days of English for faster more complete learning. This is the best way to learn a language. The goal is to rapidly build confidence and language skills.

Extra Conversation & Pronunciation: *Fridays 9am-12pm only*

Build your vocabulary and conversation while specifically working on pronunciation.

Advanced Grammar Review & Writing. *Monday and Wednesday*

Advanced grammar review, weekly writing of essays with feedback and correction. The goal of this course is to help learners to speak and write English more accurately and confidently.
