



Accelerated Career dual enrollment students can simultaneously earn a high school diploma AND (1) any college Associates Degree or (2) any college diploma or (3) two approved certificates.

Required high school courses include:

- 2 English, 2 Math, 2 Science, 2 Social Studies, 1 Health/PE
- Courses can be completed through dual enrollment or through the high school

Required college program of study:

- · Any Associates Degree or
- Any Diploma
- One of the following Certificate Groups:
 - Automotive: 6 classes total 2 semesters

Auto Electrical Systems Tech (Program code AE41) and pick one of the following:

Chassis Technician Specialist (Program code ASG1)

Climate Control System (Program code AH21)

Engine Performance Technician (Program code AE51)

*Students must be 16 years old by the beginning of the semester for all certificates

■ **Drafting/CAD:** 5 classes total - 3 semesters

Drafters Assistant (Program code DA31) CAD Operator (Program code CP41)

■ Early Childhood Education: 5 classes total – 3 semesters

Early Childhood Care and Education Basics (Program code EC31)

Child Development Specialist (Program code CD61)

*Student must be 18 years old when taking the last class ECCE 1121

■ Welding: 4 classes total - 2 semesters

Gas Metal Arc Welder (Program code GM31)

Gas Tungsten Arc Welder (Program code GTA1)

*Students must be 16 years old by the beginning of the semester for both certificates
