

**Accelerated Career dual enrollment students can simultaneously earn a high school diploma AND (1) any college Associates Degree or (2) any college diploma or (3) two approved certificates.**

**Required high school courses include:**

- 2 English, 2 Math, 2 Science, 2 Social Studies, 1 Health/PE
- Courses can be completed through dual enrollment or through the high school

**Required college program of study:**

- Any Associates Degree or
- Any Diploma
- One of the following Certificate Groups:
  - **Automotive: 6 classes total – 2 semesters**  
Auto Electrical Systems Tech (Program code AE41)  
and pick one of the following:  
Chassis Technician Specialist (Program code ASG1)  
Climate Control System (Program code AH21)  
Engine Performance Technician (Program code AE51)  
*\*Students must be 16 years old by the beginning of the semester for all certificates*
  - **Drafting/CAD: 5 classes total – 3 semesters**  
Drafters Assistant (Program code DA31)  
CAD Operator (Program code CP41)
  - **Early Childhood Education: 5 classes total – 3 semesters**  
Early Childhood Care and Education Basics (Program code EC31)  
Child Development Specialist (Program code CD61)  
*\*Student must be 18 years old when taking the last class ECCE 1121*
  - **Welding: 4 classes total – 2 semesters**  
Gas Metal Arc Welder (Program code GM31)  
Gas Tungsten Arc Welder (Program code GTA1)  
*\*Students must be 16 years old by the beginning of the semester for both certificates*

Students must be accepted to Gwinnett Tech and register for courses.
