Veterinary Technology Degree Application Instructions Fall 2024 Application and Prerequisite Deadline: June 1, 2024

Step 1:Complete the attached Veterinary Technology Degree application form.Read the instructions and application requirements very carefully. This is a
writable form and does not need to be printed out.

Please save to your computer, fill out the form, and save it back to your computer once you have completed the application. Before you email your application, please check all your attached documents to make sure your application is complete and make changes if necessary to your application before you submit it to <u>healthapp@GwinnettTech.edu</u>. If there is any missing information or documentation, we will reject your application and you will receive an email why your application was rejected. You will need to correct these items and return the application and all documentation before the June 1st deadline.

- Step 2: Review your GTC Transcript to confirm that all prerequisites are accurately reflected. Save a copy of your Gwinnett Technical College academic transcript to your computer.
 - Log on to gwinnetttech.edu/dashboard/
 - Click on "Student/Faculty Secure Area"
 - User Name: FLLLLLXXXX (F=first initial lowercase L=first 6 of last name lowercase XXXX= last four digits of student 900 number)
 - Password: Enter default (gtcmmddyy) or your customized password).
 - Click on "Student Services and Financial Aid"
 - Click on "Student Records"
 - Click on "Academic Transcript"
 - Click on "Submit"

When you pull up your transcript in BANNER WEB right click on the page and select print and in the destination, field select SAVE AS PDF and save to your computer to attach to your email with your application. *NOTE FOR APPLICANTS EXPECTING TRANSFER CREDIT: Applicants will need to be accepted into Gwinnett Technical College at least <u>4 weeks prior to the June 1st deadline</u> to ensure that transfer credits have enough time to be evaluated and transferred in. The official evaluation process does not begin until a student is accepted and can take between 4-6 weeks. Once the official evaluation is complete, the credits that have been accepted will be transferred in and will show on your Gwinnett Technical College Transcript. If any pre-requisites have been taken at other institutions and are not reflected on your Gwinnett Technical College transcript 4-6 weeks after acceptance, *or* if you are accepted less than 4 weeks prior to the June 1st deadline, please e-mail the Healthcare Team at HealthTeam@GwinnettTech.edu.

Step 3: Take the TEAS Exam:


- The ATI TEAS Exam is offered by appointment at the Gwinnett Technical College Assessment Center and is given on campus and remotely.
- The ATI TEAS exam must be taken between June 2, 2023 and the application deadline of June 1, 2024. A copy of the score report must be submitted with your application packet. Go into your ATI TEAS account to get a copy of your score report.
- The cost of the ATI TEAS Exam, which is paid online directly to ATI TEAS at the time your appointment is made. NO REFUND is available.
- The minimum score to apply is 50%. No exceptions allowed.
- Students must register for the ATI TEAS Exam at <u>atitesting.com</u>. Please create an account and select Gwinnett Technical College AH (Allied Health) as your institution. Once you have created your ATI TEAS account you need to register to take the test at Gwinnett Tech by selecting the Register for TEAS option on the home page.
- Applicants may take the ATI TEAS Exam a maximum of 2 times per application cycle at Gwinnett Technical College. No wait period between exams.
- STUDENTS MAY ALSO TEST AT OTHER INSTITUTIONS and have their scores sent electronically from ATI to Gwinnett Technical College. Note: All scores must be sent officially from ATI to Gwinnett Tech and received by our Assessment Center in order for student to apply. A copy of the score report must be submitted as part of your application packet. You may obtain the score report from the GTC Assessment Center. We accept both the ATI TEAS for Allied Health and ATI TEAS for Nursing Students.

- The highest ATI TEAS Exam score earned within the application cycle will be accepted.
- To request an ATI TEAS transcript, visit atitesting.com.

 Click on Student Home page; select My Results tab; select Share Results link; select Gwinnett Technical College AH as your institution; click continue to open the Shopping Cart, and then click Check Out to open the secure checkout page. ATI TEAS Exam transcripts cost \$27.00 and is paid directly to ATI TEAS.

Step 4:Complete the Veterinary Technology Application Form with <u>all</u> required
information.
Be sure to attach a copy of your current:

- Gwinnett Technical College unofficial transcript downloaded from gwinnetttech.edu/dashboard/
- Driver's license
- Permanent Resident Card only if you are not a U.S. citizen.
- ATI TEAS Exam score report (Example below)



Step 5:Submit your completed application packet to the email address
healthapp@gwinnetttech.edu
no later than the June 1st application deadline.
If you would like to submit your application in person you may do so by
scheduling a QLess appointment with a Healthcare Enrollment Advisor on the
Lawrenceville campus. Your packet will be reviewed by an advisor for accuracy
and completion before being submitted for processing.

Incomplete application packets will not be accepted.

If your prerequisite GPA is below the 2.65 or your ATI TEAS Exam score is below 50%, you are not eligible to apply to the Veterinary Technology degree program. Also, if you cumulative GPA is below 2.0 you cannot apply to the Vet Tech program, you must be in good academic standing.

If we find any errors with your application or incomplete applications, you will be emailed that your application has been rejected and you will need to reapply to correct any errors found.

You will be notified by your student email account if you have been accepted into the program. Please start checking your student email account the day after your application deadline. Check your student email account everyday, it could take several weeks to receive this email.

Gwinnett Technical College Veterinary Technology Degree Competitive Application

The Veterinary Technology program requires the following courses to be completed by the application prerequisite deadline. Each course must be completed with a minimum grade of "C". A student may retake a course, but only the most recent attempt will be considered in this **initial selection process**. The **final selection process** will include additional criteria such as, prerequisite GPA, ATI TEAS Exam score, mandatory orientation, etc.

Please identify where and when each course was completed, and the letter grade attained. If you repeated a required course, please list information related to the **most recent attempt**. Gwinnett Technical College must have an official transcript on file for each college previously attended. Please view your Gwinnett Technical College academic transcript through Self-Service BANNER Web to find the dates and grades for specific courses completed with Gwinnett Technical College.

The current requirement for the Veterinary Technology program is Biology 1111/L or BIOL 2107/L and Chemistry 1151/L or 1211/L. Beginning in Fall 2025, Chemistry will no longer be required and is being replaced with Biology 1112 and 1112L.

Since the Vet Tech program starts a new cohort only in the Fall semester this change will be implemented over the next 3 years as follows:

Gwinnett Tech will take any combination of the classes listed below until Fall 2025, when we will no longer accept any Chemistry classes. Applicants applying for the Fall 2025 cohort can only use BIOL 1111/L and BIOL 1112/L.

Candidate selection is based on a competitive selection process, which includes prerequisite **GPA of 2.65** or higher and **ATI TEAS Exam Score of 50%** or higher, mandatory orientation, etc.
- I understand this application, along with all course information and supporting documents (driver's license, Permanent Resident card if not a US Citizen, and ATI TEAS Exam score report), must be emailed to healthapp@gwinnetttech.edu by the application deadline of June 1, 2024. Or if you would like to submit your application in person you may do so by scheduling a QLess appointment with a Healthcare Enrollment Advisor on the Lawrenceville campus. I also understand incomplete packets will not be considered for the Veterinary Technology program.
- I understand that all students in the Veterinary Technology program **are required to be vaccinated against Rabies**. Proof of vaccination must be shown by the beginning of VETT 1030: Veterinary Clinical Procedures I (2nd semester after admission into the Veterinary Technology program). The Rabies vaccination protocol is 2 doses spread out over a 21-28 day period. The vaccine can be acquired at your primary care physician, county health department, most travel clinics, or other vaccine provider.
