5.5.6 GT Confidentiality

Included in this **confidentiality** are student grades, student records, student actions, and overall student performance. Teachers and staff should maintain this confidentiality except when discussing the student records or performance for such purposes as placement, advisement, and other instances that are in the best interest of the student.
