7.1.6 GT Physical Facilities

Purpose

The purpose and mission of Gwinnett Technical College is the basis for the total operation of the College. The physical facility is designed to help achieve the purpose and mission of the College and any changes to the facilities are done with this in mind.

Evaluation and Planning

The evaluation and planning of the physical facilities is an ongoing process. Modifications or adaptations to the facility are identified through the long-range planning process and involve all necessary staff and any outside personnel needed to fulfill the mission.

Growth Potential

Gwinnett Technical College's Lawrenceville campus is located on a site of 85.507 acres, which is sufficient for present enrollment and allows for adequate expansion of the existing building and the addition of other buildings to meet the future needs of the college. Gwinnett Technical College's Alpharetta-North Fulton campus is located on 25 acres of land with identified sites for 3 total buildings.

Landscape

The landscape plan for Gwinnett Technical College provides for both an aesthetic and functional design for the total site. Any modification in the existing facility or consideration of additional building is incorporated into the total plan in order to maintain an integrated landscape design.

Detailed plans regarding site and landscape design are available for review in the facilities office.

Building Design

The design, arrangement, and construction of the buildings facilitate the purpose of the College and the objectives of the programs. The architectural design and construction of the buildings are conducive to effective instruction, flexible programming, efficient maintenance and management, and economical operation.

The buildings meet all local, state, and national building codes required in the area. They also meet all specifications set forth by the Technical College System of Georgia.

The buildings are designed with the flexibility of being able to modify facilities as changes in programs occur or new programs are added. The buildings meet the requirements of Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
