GSFAPP Instructions

To receive aid for <u>Accelerated Career Pathway</u> follow the steps below to complete the GSFAPP (Georgia Student Finance Application):

1. Access the GSFAPP portal:

- Go to the GA Futures website: www.gafutures.org.
- Navigate to "HOPE & State Aid Programs" on the top menu.
- Click on "State Aid Applications" then "Accelerated Career Education Grant".

2. Login or Create an Account:

- If you already have a GaFutures account, log in using your credentials.
- If not, create a new account by providing your personal information.

3. Basic Information:

 Verify your personal details including name, date of birth, Social Security number, and contact information.

4. Student Information:

- · Select your current academic status
- · Enter details about your high school
- Indicate your intended major and graduation date.

5. College Selection:
