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8.1 GT Career Advisement

The Career Services Center provides career assessment resources for those Gwinnett Technical College students who are struggling to identify their career and education paths. The assessment tools help individuals identify their career interests, abilities and work-related values, while providing important information about occupations, schools, and academic programs.

Career Advisement - Procedure

Several options are available to assist prospective and current students with career planning. Students may choose from the following options:

1. Career Cruising, an interactive internet software program that can be conveniently accessed from any computer with internet capability. In addition to helping individuals identify their career interests, abilities, and work-related values this self-assessment program provides information about occupations.
2. Career Choice Seminar is designed specifically for individuals struggling with a career direction. The Myers Briggs Type Indicator (MBTI) is used in these sessions.
3. Career Scope evaluates a person's interests and aptitude and recommends occupational areas suited to their profile.
4. Career Advisors help students evaluate their results and develop a career plan.
