



## **Kaplan Exam**

**The Kaplan Nursing School Admissions Test** is a pre-admissions assessment to determine whether a student has the necessary academic skills to perform effectively in a school of nursing.

All candidates for the Nursing, Nursing Bridge and Practical Nursing program are required to take the Kaplan Exam at Gwinnett Technical College before their published application deadline.

| Nursing           | Minimum Score: 75 | Fall Application Deadline: February 15  |  |

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE KAPLAN EXAM:

- ➤ Candidates for the Nursing, Nursing Bridge and the Practical Nursing Program MUST take the Kaplan exam at Gwinnett Technical College.
- The Kaplan Exam is offered by appointment only.

- Follow the enrollment steps to register your account.
- Then, you will need to also register with the school to take the Kaplan Admissions Test at their specified date/time and testing location:
  - Registration for the Kaplan Exam is done on line at the Gwinnett Technical College Assessment Center page, which can be accessed using the following web address: <a href="mailto:gwinnetttech.edu/programs/assessment-testing-center/">gwinnetttech.edu/programs/assessment-testing-center/</a>
  - Payment for proctoring the exam is completed at registration for the exam through RegisterBlast.
- Applicants may take the Kaplan Exam a maximum of 2 times per application cycle per program at Gwinnett Technical College's Assessment Center.
  - Students must wait a minimum of 30 days after completing their first Kaplan Exam before retesting.
  - The student's highest Kaplan Exam score from the current application cycle will be accepted.
- Students have about 2 ¾ hours to finish the Kaplan Exam. Content, sub-content areas and time per section are:
