## Transition Steps from Dual Enrollment to Regular Admit Student



### APPLICATION:

1. Submit an Admissions Application as a Re-Admit student.  
Scan the QR code the Admissions Application.



### SUBMIT:

2. Submit your current in-progress high school transcript

You can have it sent electronically from GaFutures.org

After steps 1 and 2 are completed, the student will be admitted as a “pending admit high school senior.” The student has until June 15th to complete step 3.

A home-study dual enrollment student must satisfy the following test score admissions requirements to transition to a regular-admit student after completing high school:  
(A) Show a college transcript of 12 credits completed with a grade of C or higher in each course or (B) Show a college transcript of ENGL 1101 and MATH 1111 completed with a grade of C or higher or (C) provide official qualifying test scores from SAT or ACT or Accuplacer.



### GETTING STARTED:

3. Submit your final official high school transcript.



### COMPLETE FAFSA:

4. Complete your FAFSA at [www.FAFSA.gov](http://www.FAFSA.gov)

You will not be eligible to receive any financial aid until after your final high school transcript has been received and processed by the college.

5. Download the QLess app to request an appointment. Appointments are available in person, phone or WebEx.
