5.3.11 GT Program Structure: General Education Courses

Gwinnett Tech follows the Technical College System of Georgia policy (5.1.6) and procedure (5.1.6p) Structure of Associate Degree, Diploma, and Technical Certificate of Credit Programs (<https://www.tcsg.edu/about-tcsg/state-board/policy-manual/>). All associate degree and diploma programs include specified general education courses. Associate degree programs require at least 15 credits of general education college-level courses; and all programs require an addition of three credits from one of the following areas: English, humanities/fine arts, social/behavioral sciences, and natural sciences/mathematics. Diploma programs require a minimum of eight credit hours in general education courses.
