## Cardiovascular Technology Degree Degree Application Instructions

**Fall 2026 Application and Prerequisite Deadline: June 8, 2026**

**Student must be currently enrolled at or accepted to Gwinnett Technical College to pursue admission to the Associate Degree Cardiovascular Technology program.**

**Step 1:** Complete the attached **Cardiovascular Technology Degree** application form. Read the instructions and application requirements very carefully. This is a writable form and does not need to be printed out. Please save to your computer, fill out the form, and save it back to your computer once you have completed the application. Before you email your application, please check all your attached documents to make sure your application is complete and make changes if necessary to your application before you submit it to [healthapp@GwinnettTech.edu](mailto:healthapp@GwinnettTech.edu). If there is any missing information or documentation, we will reject your application and you will receive an email why your application was rejected. You will need to correct these items and return the application and all documentation before the **June 8th** deadline.

**Step 2:** Review your Gwinnett Technical College Transcript to confirm that all prerequisites are accurately reflected. To review & save to your computer your Gwinnett Technical College academic transcript:

- Log on to [gwinnettech.edu/dashboard/](http://gwinnettech.edu/dashboard/)
- User name: FLLLLLXXXX (F=first initial lowercase L=first 6 of last name lowercase XXXX= last four digits of student 900 number)
- Password: Enter default (gtcmmddy) or your customized password).
- Click on "Ellucian Experience Banner"
- Click on "Student Profile Info & Fees Tile"
- Click on "Student Profile" located in tile
- On left hand side of page select "Academic Transcript"
- Select Transcript Level "All Level"
- Click on Transcript Type - Unofficial Transcript
- **When your transcript displays, click the "Print Icon" on the right hand side of the page. A print window will pop up, change the destination field, select SAVE AS PDF and save to your computer to attach to your email with your application.**

**\*NOTE FOR APPLICANTS EXPECTING TRANSFER CREDIT:** Applicants will need to be accepted into Gwinnett Technical College at least **4 weeks prior to the application deadline** to ensure that transfer credits have enough time to be evaluated and transferred in. The official evaluation process does not begin until a student is accepted and can take between 4-6 weeks. Once the official evaluation is complete, the credits that have been accepted will be transferred in and will show on your Gwinnett Technical College Transcript.

### Step 3: Take the TEAS Exam:

- The ATI TEAS Exam is offered by appointment at the Gwinnett Technical College Assessment Center and is given on campus. To register for the ATI TEAS Exam, go to [atitesting.com](http://atitesting.com). Please create an account and select Gwinnett Technical College AH (Allied Health) as your institution.
- **The minimum score to apply is 75.**
- The cost of the ATI TEAS exam is paid Online directly to ATI TEAS at the time your appointment is made. NO REFUND is available.
- The ATI TEAS exam must be ***less than three (3) years old and taken ON CAMPUS ONLY***. **TEAS scores that are taken “REMOTE” (Online) will not be accepted.**
- The last date to take the ATI TEAS exam will be **May 29th for the June 8th deadline**. No exceptions allowed for test dates passed **May 29th**.
- Applicants may take the ATI TEAS Exam a maximum of 2 times per application cycle with no wait period at Gwinnett Technical College.
- Students may also test at other institutions and have their scores sent electronically from ATI to Gwinnett Technical College.
- **STUDENTS WHO TEST AT OTHER INSTITUTIONS** must take the exam ***IN PERSON by May 29th***. **TEAS scores that are taken “REMOTE” (Online) will not be accepted.** Official score report must be sent from ATI to the Gwinnett Tech Assessment Center before the June 8th deadline. We accept both the TEAS for Allied Health and the TEAS for Nursing Students.
- The highest ATI TEAS (Allied Health) Exam score earned within the application cycle will be accepted. You may obtain the score report from the GTC Assessment Center
- To request an ATI TEAS transcript, visit [atitesting.com](http://atitesting.com) and:
  - Click on Student Home page; select My Results tab; select Share Results link; select Gwinnett Technical College AH as your institution; click continue to open the Shopping Cart, and then click Check Out to open the secure checkout page. ATI TEAS Exam transcripts are \$27.00 and is paid directly to ATI TEAS.

### Step 4: Complete the Program Application Form below with all required information. Attach all required documentation to your email as separate documents.

#### **Be sure to attach a copy of your current:**

- **Driver's license**
- **Permanent Resident Card - only if you are not a U.S. citizen.**
- **ATI TEAS Exam score report (example below) must test in person.**
- **Gwinnett Technical College unofficial transcript (Review Step 2 above)**





**Step 5:** Submit your completed application packet to the email address [healthapp@GwinnettTech.edu](mailto:healthapp@GwinnettTech.edu). Your packet will be reviewed by an advisor for accuracy and completion before being submitted for processing. Incomplete application packets will not be accepted. **If your overall GPA is below 2.00, prerequisite competitive GPA is below 3.00, or your ATI TEAS Exam score is below 75%, you are not eligible to apply to the program.**

**If we find any errors with your application or incomplete applications, you will be emailed that your application has been rejected and you will need to reapply to correct any errors found.**

**You will be notified by your student email account with an invitation to attend the mandatory meeting if you are one of the top competitive applicants for the program. Please start checking your student email account the day after the application deadline. Check your student email account everyday, it could take several weeks to receive this email.**

In addition to earning a minimum grade of "C" in each course, **an overall GPA of 3.00 must be earned in the required prerequisite courses.** A student may retake a course, however only the most recent attempt will be considered for the prerequisite GPA calculation used for this **initial screening process.** The final selection process will include additional criteria such as, prerequisite GPA, ATI TEAS Exam results, etc.

If you repeated a required course, please list information related to the **most recent attempt.** Gwinnett Technical College must have an official transcript on file for each college previously attended. BIOL classes completed prior to Summer Semester of 2021 will be considered expired and PHYS 1110 classes completed prior to Summer Semester of 2016 will be considered expired. Expired classes must be retaken or an exemption exam passed within the current application cycle in order to apply. - \_\_\_ I understand that completion of prerequisite courses and meeting other minimum requirements does not guarantee selection to the program, as there are a limited number of seats available in the occupational and clinical courses. Candidate selection is based on a competitive selection process, which includes **prerequisite GPA of 3.00** or higher and **ATI TEAS Exam Score of 75%** or higher and a **mandatory orientation if you are a top candidate**, etc.
- \_\_\_ Please be aware that our partner clinical sites are requiring students to complete their COVID-19 vaccine series. Each clinical site reserves the right to deny a student entry based on their own policies and procedures. If a student does not have all required immunizations and tests, the student may have limited access to clinical sites, which may delay or prevent program completion. As a result, successful completion of the program may not be possible.
- \_\_\_ I understand this application, along with all course information and supporting documents (**driver’s license, Permanent Resident card if not a US Citizen, ATI TEAS Exam score report - no remote testing allowed, and unofficial transcript**), must be emailed to [HealthApp@GwinnettTech.edu](mailto:HealthApp@GwinnettTech.edu) by the application deadline of **June 8th**. I also understand **incomplete packets will not be considered for the program**.
