5.1.25 GT Experiential Credit

Experiential credit refers to credit that a student receives by examination or for non-collegiate sponsored instruction.

1. Credit will be granted only to currently enrolled students.
2. Credit will be granted only for courses which are available at Gwinnett Technical College and for which subject area experts are available for appropriate review.
3. Credit will be granted only for courses in which the student demonstrates attainment of all critical competencies and at least 80 percent of all identified competencies.
4. Credit will not be granted for courses also taken for credit through normal registration procedures either before or after the award of experiential learning credits.
5. Credit will be recorded on the transcript as "EX."
6. The maximum number of credit hours for which a student can receive experiential credit is 15 semester hours.

Course Credit

Course credit awarded by other than satisfactory completion of a course at Gwinnett Technical College may be earned for the following:

- Advanced Placement Credit
- Secondary Articulation Credit
- College Level Examination Placement Credit (CLEP)
- Exemption Exam
- Credit by Transfer

- DSST (DANTES Subject Standardized Tests)
- Non-Collegiate Course Credit
