7.1.2 GT Environmental Control

The utilities and environmental control systems of the college provide adequate working conditions for students and staff. All utilities are adequate to serve collegial needs and conform to local codes. Special environmental controls such as exhaust, air filtration, sterilization, and humidity control systems are adequately provided based on program requirements. In addition, a computerized energy management system is in operation to ensure maximum environmental control at minimal cost.
