

The **HOPE Career Grant** is available to students enrolled in an eligible diploma or certificate program who are also receiving the **HOPE Grant** (Georgia resident, U.S. citizen, 2.0 GPA) or Zell Miller Grant (Georgia resident, U.S. citizen, 3.5 GPA).

Gwinnett Tech tuition: \$107/credit; Fees \$478/semester

- **Zell Miller Grant:** \$107/credit
 - Diploma and Certificate level programs
- **HOPE Grant:** \$100/credit (same as HOPE scholarship)
 - Diploma and Certificate level programs
- **HOPE Career Grant:** Amount determined by registered credit hours when enrolled in an approved program
 - \$500/semester for 9+ credits; \$250/semester for 3-8 credits

HOPE SCHOLARSHIP

- Georgia eligible high school graduate within the past 7 years
- 3.0 GPA or higher at high school graduation
- Maintain a 3.0 GPA while in college
- Meet U.S. citizenship and GA residency requirements for at least one year

- Associates degree programs
- Can be full-time or part-time

- Covers tuition at \$100/credit, up to 127 credits in Associates degree program

- Complete the FAFSA and GSFAPP



HOPE GRANT

- Must maintain a 2.0 GPA while in college
- Meet U.S. citizenship and GA residency

- Diploma or Certificate programs
- Can be full-time or part-time

- Covers tuition at \$100/credit, up to 63 credits in a Diploma or Certificate program
- If also in a HOPE Career Grant program, then eligible to receive:
 - \$500/term is taking 9+ credits
 - \$250/term if taking 3-8 credits
 - \$125/term if taking 1-2 credits
